Mother's Day Scone Recipe

Ingredients

1 Cup Pure Cream
3 Cups Self-Raising Flour
Pinch of Salt
Extra Flour (For Dusting)
Jam and Cream (To Serve)



Method

- 1. Preheat oven to 220deg Celsius (200dec Celsius fan-forced)
- 2. Lightly flour a baking tray
- 3. Sift flour and salt into a large bowl. Pour in lemonade and cream and mix to a soft, sticky dough. Scrape onto a generously floured surface. Knead very lightly and press into 3cm thick disc. Using a 6cm cutter, cut dough into rounds and place on a baking paper lined oven tray. Gently knead scraps of dough together, repeat pressing and cutting.
- 4. Lightly brush tops with a little extra cream and bake for 15-20 minutes until tops are browned.
- 5. Serve with jam and cream.
