





4/5 A Snapshot

4/5 B Snapshot

In Maths our learning focused on how to accurately estimate where a number should go on a number line. The strategy that we practised involved breaking the number line down into smaller sections to more accurately place the number where it belongs.

In order to make this task a little more engaging, and to take advantage of the beautiful weather we currently have, we took some chalk outside and drew number lines onto the concrete. It was very fun, and lovely to complete our learning in a different environment!
