It has been another great week at DWPS.

On Wednesday we were fortunate to have our maths consultant onsite working with classes and teams. Through his regular visits we are really seeing an improvement in our students' confidence and the ways in which they respond to their learning tasks.

Forming part of our maths model is a 'Maths Talk', during which a problem is posed to our students. They are asked to articulate to their peers how they have managed solve it mentally. This practice allows students to see what other strategies have been employed and build upon them. Not only does it build inclusivity through the sharing of different perspectives and strategies, it allows the opportunity for our students to see there are so many different ways to approach mathematical problems.

Athletics Day yesterday was a huge success. A massive well done to everyone for their efforts. Our students did a great job stepping out of their comfort zone to experience a range of new events. It was so nice to hear about the care and compassion that our students showed towards each other. Kindness and encouragement and looking out for each other are at the core of our school's values.

A big thank you to Mr Scott Shaw who worked hard to put the day together and to the Warragul Regional students and our parent volunteers who provided assistance at the events.

The temporary fencing separating us from the kinder opened up this week, it was so lovely to see the connections being made through the fence. Our cricket nets and long jump pit have been reinstalled and have proved very popular once again. The installation of the fencing along the carpark hopefully won't be too much longer.



Myth Busting NAPLAN! With Miss Winter & Mr G

Myth: 'My child has a disability and cannot participate in NAPLAN.'

Reasonable support and adjustments are available for students with disability to participate in NAPLAN tests where possible.

Students may be able to access assistance such as a scribe for a writing task or a NAPLAN support person.

Adjustments should reflect similar support provided in the classroom for students to show what they know and can do in the tests.

Parents of students with disability are encouraged to discuss options with their child's teacher before the tests to support their participation in NAPLAN. It is important that NAPLAN results are representative of the entire student population, including students with disability. For more information on adjustments, visit the ACARA website.

Myth: 'Naplan tests are out of date.'

NAPLAN tests are designed each year to align with the

Australian/Victorian Curriculum. NAPLAN has transitioned from


paper-based to online testing over the past few years, with all students undertaking

NAPLAN online unless their circumstances prevent them from doing so.

NAPLAN Online is an adaptive 'tailored test design', presenting students with more questions pitched at their individual achievement level, thus increasing the accuracy of the results. Completing Naplan online also means that there will be a faster turnaround of information between testing and the return of results to the school.

We hope this information has been helpful, please reach out to your child's teacher if you have questions around the upcoming NAPLAN testing.
