Some of you have walked through the Year 2/3 gallery and enjoyed the fresh smell of toast on a Tuesday or Friday.

Everyone though has a different impression of what *Breaky Club* might be so I thought I'd give you a little but more info. So what actually is breaky club at Drouin West Primary School? It is simply a time before school on a Tuesday or Friday where students can have some breakfast!
