


Its been a very busy Term One in the Art Room for the students. The Prep students started with a gorgeous Food dye wax resist piece of a cute giraffe they enjoyed seeing how the dye reacted to the wax on the paper.



The year One students worked using the same techniques and designed a fish multimedia wax resist collage. Both the prep and year one students started to use their visual diaries and completed a graffiti inspired name design on the front cover of their visual diary. They also created fablous fish designed hangings and plaques, and glazed them using underglazes and clear gloss glaze.





The Year 4,5 and 6 students also learnt about tonal gradation and worked on an painting using Cromacryl acrylic paints called Sunset Reeds. They learnt to blend colours to create a gradation of tone and added the reeds with paint and Fine liner.

For the Prep and One students our Artist Focus for the term was the French Impressionist artist Claude Monet and his iconic paintings of his water lily garden in Giverny. The Preps and Ones use acrylic paint for the back ground and soft chalk pastels for the lily flowers.



The rest of the school was immersed in Vincent Van Gogh. The year 2and 3 students looked at his Sunflower Paintings and learnt how to paint a beautiful painting inspired by his Sunflower paintings.

Year 7 2024 – Neerim District Secondary College



The first event is a **2024 Year 7 Parent Information Evening held at Drouin West Primary School on Monday 8th May 6:00pm to 7:00pm.** At this time, NDSC Principal Michael Shone, Year 7 Transition Coordinator Jordan Downs, and a current student will speak to us about Year 7 at NDSC, their 2024 Year 7 transition program, and the schools' middle and senior school programs. Parents and students from 2023 Grade 5 and Grade 6 are invited and strongly encouraged to attend. At this event, Michael will also speak with parents/carers about opportunities for an optional additional visit to Neerim District Secondary College this year for a one-on-one daytime tour and/or to attend an information evening at the school in Term 2.

Neerim District Secondary College are also holding four 'Discovery Days' across Terms 2 and 3 for our Grade 6 students this year. The purpose of these days is for Grade 6 students to spend the day at NDSC participating in a program that introduces them to secondary school. On these days, Grade 6 students from all NDSC feeder Primary schools will participate in a range of fun, educational and engaging activities and there is a different program and different activities on each of the days. On NDSC Discovery Days Grade 6 students will travel to and from the secondary school by bus, departing after 9:00am from Drouin West PS and returning to our school before the end of the school day. The first NDSC Discovery Day is **Term 2 Friday 19th May** and more information, including a consent form, will be provided to parents/carers at the start of Term 2.
