Over the course of the year, we are updating and refreshing some of our learning spaces. We are so impressed with how inviting and nurturing our classroom environments are.

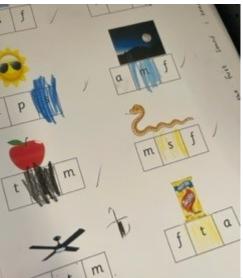

Stace has done an amazing job on putting together the program and preparing the children.

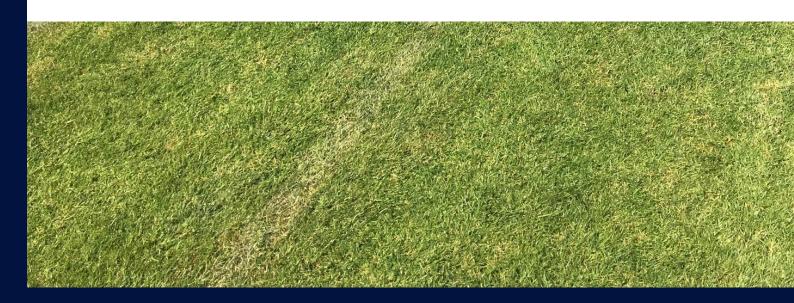
